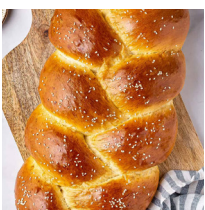

RABBI'S MESSAGE

One of the most frustrating things in life is forgetting your password!

First, they asked for a password. So we gave them a password.

They said that's too easy to remember. So we gave them a different password.

They said that's still too easy to remember. So, we conjured up a very complicated and difficult password.

They said, Perfect, that's a very hard password to remember. And sure enough, we could never again remember the password!

We try one, then another, then another. Wrong; wrong; wrong. We keep trying, racking our brains. Then we're told, no more! No more trying. To protect the safety of your account, you need to stop trying to get into it. Go do something else.

The account is perfectly safe because no one will ever access it again. Not even its perfectly legal owners. Despite all our protesting and weeping, we will never be allowed into our own account. That's how good the password was. It was that good.

We try to reason: "Hey, it's my account! How can you block entry to my account? I am the boss! Let me in!" Nothing. Silence. So, there you are. What to do?

The famous Baal Shem Tov - founder of the Chassidic movement - shared the following parable:

"A King had an only son, the apple of his eye. The King wanted his son to master different fields of knowledge and to experience various cultures, so he sent him to a far-off country, supplied with a generous quantity of silver and gold.

"Far away from home, the son squandered all the money until he was left completely destitute. In his distress, he resolved to return to his father's house and after much difficulty, he managed to arrive at the gate of the courtyard to his father's palace.

"In the passage of time, he had actually forgotten the language of his native country, and he was unable to identify himself to the guards. In utter despair, he began to cry out in a loud voice, and the King, who recognized the voice of his son, went out to him and brought him into the house, kissing him and hugging him.

RABBI'S MESSAGE CONTINUED...

The meaning of the parable: The King is G-d. The prince is each one of us. The King sends a soul down to this world in order to fulfill the Torah and Mitzvot. However, the soul becomes very distant and forgets everything to which it was accustomed to above, and in the long exile it forgets even its own "language." So, it utters a simple cry to its Father in Heaven.

"This", taught the Baal Shem Tov, "is the idea of the blowing of the shofar, a cry from deep within, expressing regret for the past and determination for the future. This cry elicits G-d's mercies, and He demonstrates His abiding affection for His child and forgives him."

This Rosh Hashanah, if you feel like you've forgotten the password to access your own soul, do not despair.

When we come to Shul and hear the Shofar blowing ceremony, G-d's voice-recognition system will unlock all Heaven's gates for you.

As Rosh Hashana approaches, we pray that G-d bless us with a year of health, happiness, and success!

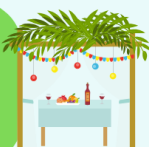

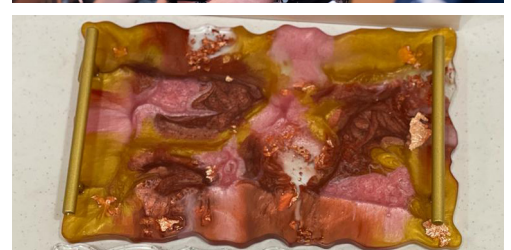
