RABBI'S MESSAGE

Over the last year and half the economic situation world-wide has seen serious fluctuation. Up and down, down and up. Some businesses thriving. Others tanking. And then the reverse. One of the things governments try to do whenever there is financial uncertainty or a looming recession is to lower taxes, at least on small businesses, in the hope that it will encourage entrepreneurs to open businesses and hire workers.

We find a similar thing in Judaism.

Everyone knows that there are 613 Mitzvahs that a Jew needs to keep. But how can G-d expect us to keep so many Mitzvahs? What does G-d want from us already? So here is what you may not know: While it's true that at the giving of the Torah, G-d gave us 613 Mitzvahs - but when the Jewish Nation was exiled from its land, G-d "lowered the taxes."

There are many Mitzvahs that can only be kept when the entire Jewish Nation is located in the Holy Land or when there is a Temple. Ever since the Exile, we can only actually keep 87 positive Mitzvahs. The purpose of that is to lighten the burden upon us, so that we'll be able to get out of our spiritual "recession" and start keeping more and more Mitzvahs.

Back in the 1930s, when America was in the Great Depression, American Jews stopped buying gifts for Bar Mitzvahs, birthdays, weddings and so on. They simply didn't have the money. They also didn't go on vacations. Instead, they started taking pleasure in less expensive things, like going to the movies or buying candies.

And so, among the new industries that sprung up at the time were the postcard and greeting card industries. Instead of spending larger amounts of money on gifts, people would send a lovely card with a few pleasant greetings written on the back.

At that time, a Jew named Irving Stone, who lived in Cleveland, started a greeting-card company and turned it into a huge business. Famously known today as American Greetings, and its Jewish founder became one of Cleveland's biggest philanthropists.

At times we may be feeling like we have a spiritual recession. But remember: what G-d expects of the Jew at such a time is a "postcard," a "greeting card"- whatever little mitzvah he or she can do: Lighting candles on Friday, putting up a Mezuzah, putting on Tefillin etc.

These are things that anyone can do, and with a lot of little Mitzvahs, it's possible to eventually become a big spiritual "philanthropist" and launch a huge "mitzvah business."

So, my friends, let us take this opportunity, as we prepare for Rosh Hashana and stand before G-d, our King, to resolve to send G-d a "postcard"—a mitzvah—every day in this coming year.

Mussie and I wish you a Shana Tova - a happy sweet new year!

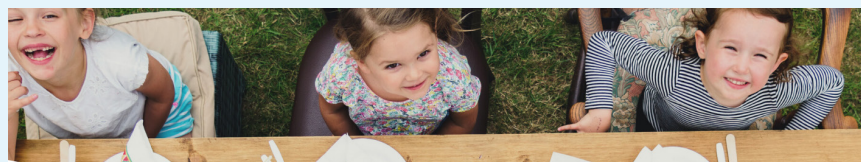
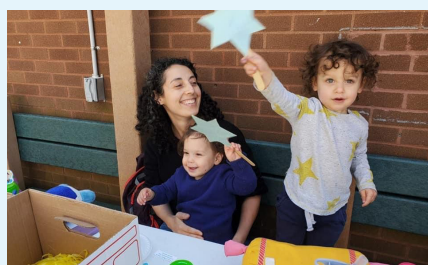
